

'Rename the university, don't shut it down'

Former AIADMK minister C Ve Shanmugham hits out against the closing down of the J Jayalalitha University

"YOU can rename it to Ambedkar University if the name is bothering you, but we will not resist closing down a university in Villupuram," said former AIADMK Law Minister C Ve Shanmugham at a protest organised by the party on Monday, against the Higher Education Minister's recent announcement on closing down J Jayalalitha University. At least 500 people took part in the protest that was held near Old Bus Stand.

Addressing the crowd, Shanmugham said, "The AIADMK government was always keen about developing Villupuram, and in 2011 the proposal for a university was almost approved by the then Chief Minister J Jayalalitha. With great efforts, we brought out the university in 2021, and on February 25, the gazette for the University was drafted and the very next day, we appointed the Vice-Chancellor. But it wasn't fully established as the Election Commission of India announced dates

for the election and so we had to refrain from further government activities."

Replying to the comment of Minister Ponmudi, who said there were no funds to develop the university, Shanmugham said, "How is it even possible for the same government to set up a library at a cost of ₹200 crore in Madurai but no funds, even as minimum as ₹100 crore, to run the university?" He further alleged that the minister had been acting out of political vengeance on the issue and that the name of the party's stalwart, Jayalalitha, bothered him that he had announced to close the university down.

"If the name of our leader is problematic to the ruling DMK, then rename it with the Father of Indian Constitution Dr BR Ambedkar. We won't resist a name change because that is not the issue. But the higher education opportunities of marginalised, Dalit and tribal students from Kallakurichi, Villupuram and Cuddalore districts are key concerns and so, at any cost we would resist the closing down," he said.

L-G meets SEC, briefs on election prep

LIEUTENANT Governor, Dr Tamilisai Soundarajan conducted a meeting with State Election Commissioner on Monday at Raj Nivas.

According to an official statement, SEC of Puducherry, Roy P Thomas called on L-G Tamilisai Soundarajan

on Monday at her office to brief her about the preparations being made to conduct Local Body elections in compliance with the Supreme Court orders.

Local body elections were not conducted in the UT for the past 10 years, despite orders issued by the High Court to conduct election. In 2018, the then Lieutenant Governor, Kiran Bedi

took action to conduct local body election, and appointed an election commissioner. Since the ruling government opposed for that appointment, election works got delayed.

Meantime, a lawyer from Mahe, Ashokumar, in April, had filed a petition at the Supreme Court to conduct the elections. The SC ordered for the election to be conducted before the first week of October.

Minister lets worker inaugurate his MLA office

Express Impact: Over 100 tribals get community certificates

"I lost government job despite having a degree due to the lack of community certificate, but that would not be the case for my daughter and sons. We all hope that now using our certificates, we can avail certificates for our generations. This is a great precedent and humane gesture by the Collector. We thank him for solving our long-pending problem," said a

48-year-old beneficiary from Kaatunayakan tribe, who receive their community certificate after a decade's struggle.

In a quick action to the stories published in these columns about Kaatunayakan and Irular tribals awaiting community certificates, District Collector D Mohan on Monday provided over 100 certificates to members of the two tribes in Vikravandi. Kanda-

chipuram, Villupuram, and Vanur taluks. This marks the beginning of an era where more than 75 per cent of the children from the community will now pursue higher education and avail better employment to improve their livelihood.

The district houses several clans of tribals, including Kaatunayakan, Irular, Kuravan, Domban and Malaikuravan, and most of them reside near

waterbodies. They were, recently rehabilitated near the plains after encroachments were removed. Their traditional occupation involves catering cattle, poultry, rearing pigs, and indulging in handicrafts of various kinds. They live in small clans across the district, usually near forest or hill areas, lacking proper housing and livelihood facilities in their settlement. Due to heightened social stigma and discrimination, they had been living the

life of an outsider without any documents of identity, such as ration card, family card, or community certificate.

About 15 members of the Kaatunayakan tribe were issued the certificate at a settlement in Nandivaadi village near Gingee. Later, 105 certificates were issued at the District Collectorate, with 87 given to Kaatunayakan and 14 to Irular people, said sources. Among them, 64 were children below 18 years of age.

The same has now been upgraded and integrated with auto scrutiny of building plan software (e-DCR software). The Hon'ble Chief Minister launched the upgraded version on 28.06.2021. The upgraded version has facility for auto scrutiny of ordinary two-storied residential buildings (G+1 structure) up to two dwelling units. Online submission of building plan application for construction of two-storied ordinary residential buildings (G+1) up to two dwelling units shall be compulsory from 01.09.2021 and no hard copies will be accepted by the Puducherry Planning Authority.
